## Maintenance/Care Tips To Ensure Quality of Protection

- ALWAYS USE compatible cleaning agents, such as REPEL® Glass & Surface Cleaner or Ammonia Free Glass Cleaner to maintain glass. (REPEL is Available on Amazon & Home Depot.com)
- Shower doors should be maintained weekly or commensurate with use, and easily rinsed with water and wiped with a clean towel or cloth (as needed). **NOTE:** If the shower has a handheld device attached, it can be effectively used at the end of shower to rinse soaps and residue off the glass.
- **ALWAYS USE** a clean, soft cloth or paper towel to clean the glass.
- DO NOT USE abrasive cleansers such as but not limited to Soft Scrub®, Ajax®, Bar Keepers Friend®, Bio-Clean®, Glass Scrub®, Mr. Clean® Magic Eraser or Comet®. Regular use of a squeegee can also be abrasive and is not recommended, as it will accelerate the wear of the protective coating.
- DO NOT USE acids, alkalis, or other strong chemical agents on the protected surface.
- **NEVER USE** abrasive cleaning pads or brushes, scrappers, razor blades, or other sharp tools on the protected glass.

## **Neglected Glass & Required Cleaning Guidelines**

Only if glass has been neglected after numerous uses and showing visible hard water and/or soap residue you cannot remove with the approved Glass Care products, the glass can be cleaned with mild, user-friendly cleaners and liquid stain removers. We suggest Eliminate® Shower Tub & Tile Cleaner, Invisible Shield® Limescale & Stain Remover, or Multi-Use CLR® (Available: Amazon, Home Depot, Lowes & Ace Hardware).

Liquid lime scale and soap scum removers safely and effectively remove calcium, hard water spots, soap scum and body oils without hurting the protective coating. Glass that is slightly neglected can become overcoated with water marks that are left to evaporate and build up on top of the Invisible Shield protective layer.

- ALWAYS USE a soft cloth, sponge, terry cloth or paper towel to clean the surface when applying cleaners such as, Eliminate® Shower Tub & Tile Cleaner, Invisible Shield® Limescale & Stain Remover, or Multi-Use CLR®
- ALWAYS USE suitable gloves if product instruction suggests.
- NEVER USE abrasive cleansers, scrubs or scoring pads to clean the glass.
